Notification

It has been observed that certain personnel registered as QCI members, through its professional membership scheme, are grossly violating the code of ethics accepted by them during registration. Non-compliances reported are of the following nature but not limited to: use of QCI logo, misuse of membership card, claiming false approval for their training courses, using membership status on letterhead, issuing false certificates, conducting surprise industry visits, all with malafide intentions.

Those who are in violation as stated above shall be terminated from the membership scheme immediately without any refunds or notice, blacklisted on the portal and legal action initiated against them at their own risks, costs and consequences. This applies with immediate effect with the approval of competent authority.
